- Visit flower nurseries for which Kalimpong is world-renowned.

- Start your day with a peaceful meditation or a morning walk.
- Visit:
 - A Thongsa Gompa (Bhutanese Monastery) the oldest monastery in Kalimpong.
 - Morgan House colonial mansion with rumoured hauntings and scenic beauty.
 - Lepcha Museum showcasing indigenous culture, instruments & weaving tools.
- Afternoon: Try traditional Kalimpong-style momo, cheese, and local pickles at a heritage cafe.

Optional: Visit to **Cactus Nursery** (Asia's largest) or indulge in a traditional **Ayurvedic** massage.
